

**Specific* admission requirements
to access to the one-year version
of the MASTER in BUSINESS ENGINEERING (120 credits)
for holders of non-Belgian degrees**

CONDITIONS :

- To hold a **second cycle university degree** (Master of minimum 60 credits) in which you have followed **minimum 45 credits equivalent** to the LSM Master 120 in Business Engineering courses.
- To hold a **first cycle university degree** (Bachelor's Degree), after three years of study (180 ECTS) including the following 108 credits:

Management and Economics	39 credits
Quantitative Methods, Sciences and Technology	36 credits
Human and Social Sciences (incl. Law)	18 credits
Languages **	15 credits

** An insufficient number of credits in foreign languages may be offset by evidence of passing an English test at level B2 of the CEFR (Common European Framework).

- To prove the **knowledge of the languages** in which the programme is taught:
 - **English:** Minimum 89 for TOEFL iBT or minimum 6.5 for the IELTS academic
You can be exempted of the English test if you can prove the entire bachelor was in English.
 - **French:** students who wish to take courses in French are required to prove their minimum B2 level through a TCF or DELF test or a proof that a first degree was taught in French.

Please note that the validity of the score is two years from the test date.

- To prove evidence of **ability to pursue second cycle studies in management.**

Students should include the results of one of the following aptitude tests in their application form:

- Minimum 550 GMAT (Institution Code 23B / Master in Business Engineering 23B-WD-54)
- Minimum 240 TageMage

You can be exempted of the GMAT test if your bachelor is from a CEMS School or DD school.

Please note that the validity of the score is two years from the test date.

REMARK :

Students can follow the full track in English. Students with a good command of French can also access a wider range of French courses and improve their language skills.
